JUDGMENT

Wherefore, including interest, judgment is hereby entered in favor of John Ella Joseph and Douglas Joseph and against William E. McNeill and Marie McNeill in the amount of Eight Thousand One Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$8,175.00).

The case against Chelsea Timber Company and Shelby Products Company is hereby dismissed.

Costs of this action are taxed to William E. and Marie McNeill.
