AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this day, by and between Ora Mae Stanley, the Wife, and Eugene Leroy Stanley, the husband,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the said Ora Mae Stanley has filed a Bill of Complaint for divorce against the said Eugene Leroy Stanley, in the Circuit Court for Shelby County, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of making a settlement of any questions of property, support, solicitor's fees, Court costs, among other things, and

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES and the mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed between the parties as follows:

1. That the real estate described in Exhibit "A" of Plaintiff's Complaint shall be the sole property of the Plaintiff, and Plaintiff shall be responsible for and pay any remaining indebtedness due thereon.
2. That each party will keep and be responsible for paying for the personal property which they now possess.
3. That the Defendant shall be responsible for the Court costs incurred in this proceeding.
4. That the Defendant shall pay to the Honorable Frank Ellis, Jr., One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars for representing the Plaintiff in these proceedings.
5. That this shall constitute a complete and total accounting and settlement of all debts and obligations, be they moral or legal, owed by the parties to each other as a result of this marriage and that by the signing of said Agreement each will mutually release the other from any further or pending claims.
6. That the plaintiff, Ora Mae Stanley, shall be permitted to return to the use of her maiden name if she so desires.

It is further understood that in the event the Court grants a decree of divorce to the Plaintiff that this Agreement may be included in said decree of divorce, the same as if the provisions hereof were the findings of the Court.
