ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Code of Alabama, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Turf Tips, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To prepare, sell, and distribute tip sheets for horse racing and any other legal activity, and each and every other activity authorized a corporation by the Code of Alabama.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand (1,000), at no par value per share. There is only one class of stock.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1840 Chandcroft Circle; the mailing address of the corporation is 1840 Chandcroft Circle, Pelham, Alabama 35124; the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Dan Spitler.

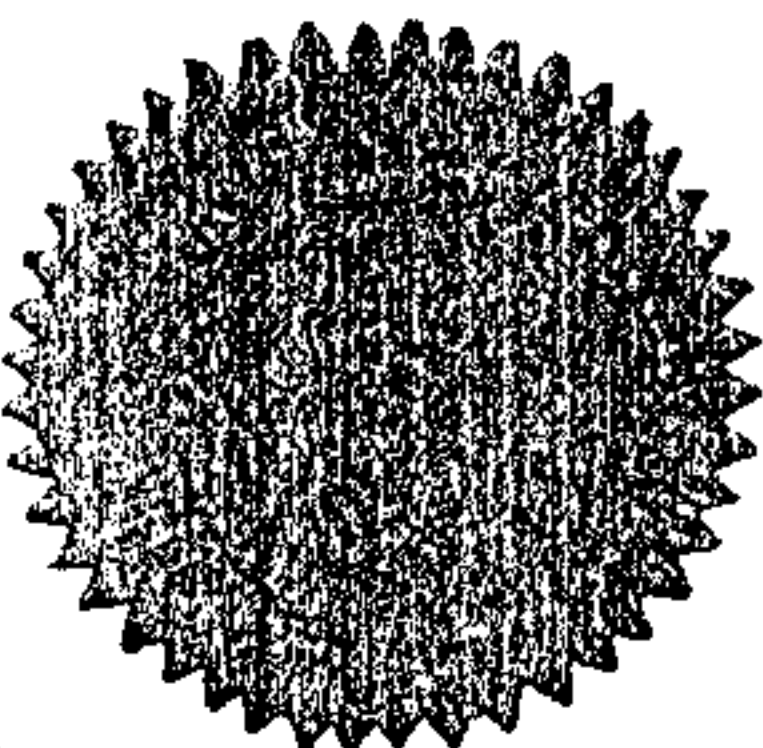
