ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
Lagman, McBrayer & Fuhrmeister, P.C.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Code of Alabama, 1975 Article 11 (10-4-220) known as the Professional Corporation Act adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Lagman, McBrayer & Fuhrmeister, P.C..

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) General practice of law

(b) To invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investment and including the ownership of real or personal property necessary or appropriate for rendering its professional service.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects and purposes of the corporation in addition to those powers specifically conferred upon the corporation by law, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing specific enumeration of powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation otherwise granted by law.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 999 with a par value of \$ \$1.00 per share.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Suite 102 200 Cahaba Park South Birmingham, AL 35243 , and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is J.A. McBrayer #17 Hunter,s Trace Pelham, AL 35124.

SIXTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is Three (3) and the names and addresses of the persons serving as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:


