ARTICLE I. Basis of Incorporation. Pursuant to Section 10-4-384, Code of Alabama, 1975, this professional corporation is incorporated under the Revised Alabama Professional Corporation Act.

ARTICLE II. Name of Corporation. The name of this professional corporation shall be :

ARTICLE III. Purposes. Pursuant to Section 10-4-383, Code of Alabama, 1975, the purposes of this professional corporation is to render professional legal services and services ancillary thereto within the profession of law.
