To have and to hold the Real Estate unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever. The Mortgagor convenants with the Mortgagee that the Mortgagor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the Real Estate and has a good right to sell and convey the Real Estate as aforesaid; that the Real Estate is free of all encumbrances, except as otherwise set forth herein, and the Mortgagor will warrant and forever defend the title to the Real Estate unto the Mortgagee, against the lawful claims of all persons.

The Mortgagor hereby authorizes the holder of any prior mortgage encumbering the Real Estate to disclose to the Mortgagee the following Information: (1) the amount of Indebtedness secured by such mortgage; (2) the amount of such indebtedness that is unpaid; (3) whether any amount owed on such indebtedness is or has been in arrears; (4) whether there is or has been any default with respect to such mortgage or the indebtedness secured thereby; and (5) any other information regarding such mortgage or the indebtedness secured thereby; and (5) any other information regarding such mortgage or the indebtedness secured thereby which the Mortgagee may request from time to time.

The Mortgagor expressly agrees that if default should be made in the payment of principal, interest or any other sum payable under the terms and provisions of the prior mortgage or mortgages listed above or any other such prior mortgage, the Mortgagee may, but shall not be obligated to, cure such default, without notice to anyone, by paying whatever amounts may be due under the terms of such prior mortgage so as to put the same in good standing; and any and all payments so made, together with interest thereon at the rate of 1-1/2% per month, or the highest rate permitted by applicable law, whichever is less, shall be added to the indebtedness secured by this mortgage. Any such amount paid by Mortgages, with Interest thereon, shall be immediately due and payable; and, if such amount is not paid in full immediately by Mortgagor, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, this mortgage shall be in default and subject to immediate foreclosure in all respects as provided by law and by the provisions hereof.

For the purpose of further securing the payment of the Debt, the Mortgagor agrees to: (1) pay all taxes, assessments, and other liens taking priority over this mortgage (hereinafter jointly called "Liens"), and if default is made in the payment of the Liens, or any part thereof, the Mortgagee, at its option, may pay the same; (2) keep the Real Estate continuously insured, in such manner and with such companies as may be satisfactory to the Mortgagee, against loss by fire, vandalism, malicious mischlef and other perils usually covered by a fire insurance policy with standard extended coverage endorsement, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgages, as its interest may appear; such insurance to be in an amount at least equal to the full insurable value of the improvements located on the Real Estate unless the Mortgagee agrees in writing that such insurance may be in a lesser amount. The original insurance policy and all replacements therefor, shall be delivered to and held by the Mortgagee until the Debt is paid in full. The insurance policy must provide that it may not be canceled without the insurer giving at least fifteen days prior written notice of such cancellation to the Mortgagee at the following address: Old Stone Credit Corporation of Ala 3940 Montclair Rd Suite 201 Birmingham AL 35213

Subject to the rights, if any, of the holder of any prior mortgage sell forth above, the Mortgagor hereby assigns and pledges to the Mortgagee as further security for the payment of the Debt each and every policy of hazard Insurance now or hereafter in effect which insures said improvements, or any part thereof, together with all the right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to each and every such policy, including but not limited to all of the Mortgagor's right, title and interest in and to any premiums paid on such hazard insurance, including ail rights to return premiums. If the Mortgagor falls to keep the Real Estate insured as specified above then, at the election of the Mortgagee and without notice to any person, the Mortgagee may declare the entire Debt due and payable and this mortgage subject to foreclosure, and this mortgage may be foreclosed as hereinafter provided; and, regardless of whether the Mortgagee declares the entire Debt due and payable and this mortgage subject to foreclosure, the Mortgagee may, but shall not be obligated to, insure the Real Estate for its full insurable value (or for such lesser amount as the Mortgagee may wish) against such risks of loss, for its own benefit, the proceeds from such insurance (less the cost of collecting same), if collected, to be credited against the Debt, or, at the election of the Mortgages, such proceeds may be used in repairing or reconstructing the improvements located on the Real Estate. All amounts spent by the Mortgages for insurance or for the payment of Liens shall become a debt due by the Mortgagor and at once payable, without demand upon or notice to the Mortgagor, and shall be secured by the lien of this mortgage, and shall bear interest from date of payment by the Mortgagee until paid at the rate of 1-1/2% per month, or the highest rate permitted by applicable law, Courtney Dason whichever is less.

not in default hereunder, the right to receive and retain such rents, profits, issues and revenues; all judgments, awards of damages and settlements hereafter made resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, under the power of eminent domain, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to the Real Estate, or any part thereof, or to any rights appurtenant thereto, including any award for change of grade of streets, and all payments made for the voluntary sale of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, in the exercise of the power of eminent domain. The Mortgagee Is hereby authorized on behalf of, and in the name of, the Mortgagor to execute and deliver valid acquittances for, and appeal from, any such judgments or awards. The Mortgagee may apply all such sums so received, or any part thereof, after the payment of all the Mortgagee's expenses, including court costs and attorneys' fees, on the Debt in such manner as the Mortgagee elects, or, at the Mortgagee's option, the entire amount or any part thereof so received may be released or may be used to rebuild, repair or restore any or all of the improvements located on the Real Estate.

The Mortgagor agrees to take good care of the Real Estate and all Improvements located thereon and not to commit or permit any waste thereon, and at all times to maintain such improvements in as good condition as they

now are, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this mortgage or the note evidencing the Debt, the Debt shall become immediately due and payable, at the option of the Mortgagee, upon the conveyance of the Real Estate, or any part thereof or any Interest therein.

The Mortgagor agrees that no delay or fallure of the Mortgages to exercise any option to declare the Debt due and payable shall be deemed a waiver of the Mortgagee's right to exercise such option, either as to any past or present default, and it is agreed that no terms or conditions contained in this mortgage may be walved, altered or changed except by a written instrument signed by the Mortgagor and signed on behalf of the Mortgages by one of its officers.

After default on the part of the Mortgagor, the Mortgagee, upon bill filed or other proper legal proceeding being commenced for the foreclosure of this mortgage, shall be entitled to the appointment by any competent court, without notice to any party, of a receiver for the rents, issues and profits of the Real Estate, with

power to lease and control the Real Estate, and with such other powers as may be deemed necessary.

Upon condition, however, that if the Mortgagor pays the Debt (which Debt includes the Indebtedness evidenced by the promissory note referred to hereinbefore and any and all extensions and renewals thereof and all interest on said indebtedness and on any and all such extensions and renewals) and reimburses the Mortgagee for any amounts the Mortgagee has paid in payment of liens, amounts in default under any prior mortgage or insurance premiums, and interest thereon, and fulfills all of its obligations under this mortgage, This conveyance shall be null and void. The Mortgagor agrees that the Mortgagee may bid at any sale had under the terms of this mortgage and may purchase the Real Estate if the highest bidder therefor.
