ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

1. The name of the corporation is:

2. No period is limited for the duration of this corporation.

3. This corporation is organized for the purpose of conducting a business of selling computers at wholesale and retail to the general public, as well as the warehousing of computers, and the transaction of any and all lawful business relating to such purpose as is permitted by the laws of the State of Alabama.

4. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand (1,000) and these shares are to be of one class only and have no par value.

5. The location and mailing address of its initial registered office shall be P. O. Box 2311, Birmingham, AL 35201 (or U.S. Highway 280 and Valley Dale Road) and the name of the initial registered agent at that address is J. Ralph Dewberry.


