THIS INSTRUMENT made and entered into on this the 16 day of  
May, 1986, by and between Finnis P. McCoy  
and Wilmie P. McCoy,  
hereinafter called Grantors; and the City of Pelham, Alabama, hereinafter called  
the Grantees;

VITIMESCHEN

WHEREAS, it has been found to provide the necessary utilities to certain  
areas lying within the city limits of the City of Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama;  
that it has been found necessary to cross certain lands owned by the Grantors for  
the purpose of installing all necessary sewer and water mains, and other such  
integral parts of water systems and sewage systems;

WHEREAS, it has been found advantageous and to the best interest of  
Grantors and Grantees that an easement for such water and sewer mains be conveyed  
to the City of Pelham, Alabama.

WHEREAS, in consideration of the sum of \$1,000,

and the mutual benefit according to the Grantors and to  
the City of Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, the Grantors have this day bargained  
and conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant and convey unto the City of  
Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, the following right, privilege and easement, in  
to, along, over, through, under and across the hereinafter described lands:

The right and privilege to construct, erect, install,  
operate and maintain sewage and water mains, on, upon,  
along, over, through, under and across the hereinafter  
described lands;

The right, privilege and easement to cut, trim and  
remove any brush, trees, or other obstructions upon  
the hereinafter described lands, together with the  
right of ingress and egress to and from, over and above  
the hereinafter described lands, for the purpose of the  
installation and upkeep of the sewage and water system.
