 - (4) Such Assistant Vice Presidents, Secretaries, Assistant Secretaries, Resident Officers and Attorneys-in-Fact shall have authority to certify or verify copies of this Resolution, the By Laws of the Company, and any affidavit or record of the Company necessary to the discharge of their duties.
 - (5) The passage of this Resolution does not revoke any earlier authority granted by Resolutions of the Board of Directors adopted on June 9, 1953 and May 28, 1975 which does hereby nominate, constitute and appoint LEE McGRIFF, H. G. SEIBELS, JR., MALCOLM K. MILLER, JR., BAKER H. DAVIS, D. E. LUDLOW and RICHARD WOMACK, all of the City of Birmingham, State of Alabama.

Each individually if there be more than one named trustee and lawful attorney-in-fact, to make, execute, seal and deliver on its behalf, and as its act and deed any and all bonds, undertakings, recognizances, contracts and other writings in the nature thereof. And the execution of such writings in pursuance of these presents, shall be as binding upon said Company, as fully and amply as if they had been duly executed and acknowledged by the regularly elected officers of the Company at its principal office.
