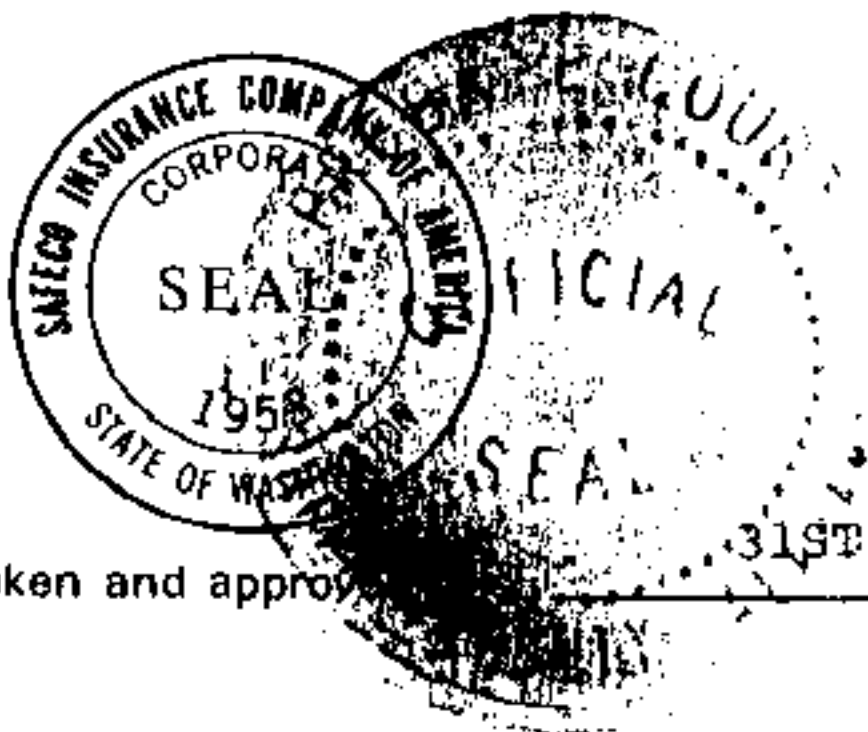
KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Melannie R. Layne
