WHEREAS, Calvary Baptist Church Foundation is and will forever be the sole property and asset of Calvany Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of Calvary Baptist Church Foundation shall be to finance a portion of the Calvary Baptist Church Annual Budget and give assistance to said church to finance special church projects from time to time, including benevolence grants to educate the gifted or retarded; and help for the poor and needy.

NOW IHEREFORE, Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama, elects the Trustees named in the Resolution to operate and manage the business of Calvary Baptist Church Foundation Pursuant to the purposes and intent of the said church as recited in the Resolution.

- 1. The Trustees of the Calvary Baptist Church Foundation met and by unanimous vote elected member, James H. Sharbutt, Chairman; member, Nolen R. Clinkscales, Vice-Chairman and his successor in office, the Treasurer of Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama; and Sara Nell Sharbutt, Secretary.
- The operation and business of the Calvary Baptist Church Foundation shall be by majority vote, and the Chairman shall receive and receipt all donations, personal and real property, disburse funds of the Foundation, sign checks for each disbursement. All three Trustees shall execute any conveyance of real estate, if any, owned by the Foundation; and authorize the Secretary to deliver such conveyance or receipt of all the consideration 300 therefor at the same time of the exchange of the conveyance and consideration.
  - 3. The Chairman may use his best judgment as to emergency expenditures as to help for the poor and needy and other expenditures of the Foundation.
  - All Foundation Trustees shall be members of Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama.
  - All Trustees shall meet from time to time and at least 5. once each calendar year to prepare a yearly report to Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama on the third Wednesday of September, 1988 at 7:00 o'clock p.m. and the same time and date of each successive year thereafter to prepare a yearly report to the membership of Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama.
- 034 PARE 340 The Trustees shall hold office until and unless removed for good cause by the membership of Calvary Baptist Church, Vincent, Alabama by two-thirds vote at a general conference, after a ten day notice posted in **B** three public places on bulletin boards of said church stating the purpose of such meeting and a copy of such written notice shall be mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, with proper postage affixed thereto, mailed to each Trustee at his or her address as last stated in the church directory.
  - 7. These By-Laws may be amended by majority vote of the Trustees at any annual meeting.
