A meeting of creditors pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §341(a) shall be held at the time and place specified in ITEM NO. 1 above at which time creditors may examine the debtor and present documented requests to abandon property.

The debtor [and joint debtor, if any] and attorney for debtor(s) shall be in attendance at the §341(a) meeting. A partnership shall appear by a general partner, a corporation by its president or other executive officer.

Failure of the debtor or his attorney to appear at the §341(a) meeting or to timely file schedules and statement of affairs may result in dismissal.

Unless extended, objection to debtor's claim of exempt property must be filed within 30 days after the §341(a) meeting.
