KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, D. C. Mitchell, of the City of Sylacauga, County of Talladega, State of Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years, and being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made.

As to my worldly estate, and all real, personal, or mixed property of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, I devise, bequeath, and dispose of in the manner following, to-wit:

First: My Will is that all of my just and honorable debts and funeral expenses shall, by my executrix, hereinafter named, be paid out of my estate, as soon after my decease as convenient.

Second: I give, devise, and bequeath all my worldly estate, and all real, personal, or mixed property, of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease, including all my household belongings, and all personal property and effects, all stocks, bonds or securities, and all moneys that I may have in any bank or be entitled to, together with all real estate or interest in real estate of which I shall die seized and possessed or to which I shall be entitled to at my decease, after my just and honorable debts and funeral expenses shall have been paid, to my dearly beloved wife, Annie Merle Mitchell.

Third: I do nominate and appoint my dearly beloved wife, Annie Merle Mitchell, of Sylacauga, Alabama, as Executrix of this, my last Will and Testament, and direct that she shall not be required to give bond for the performance of her duties arising hereunder; nor shall she be required to make any inventory of the property coming into her hands as such Executrix, nor make any report to any Court of her proceedings hereunder.

IN TESTIMONY WHERE, I, the said D. C. Mitchell, have to this my last Will and Testament, set my hand and seal, on this, to-wit: the 17th day of November, 1952.
