I, Ila Loretta Sullivan, residing at 1340 Woodland Avenue S. W., Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament and hereby revoke all former Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me.

First, I direct my Executors to pay, out of my estate, all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral expenses as soon as may be found convenient.

Second: I hereby nominate my children, Percy E. Sullivan, Jr., Bobby D. Cranford, and ^{Bobbie} Anna Lee Davis as co-executors of this Will. Should either of them die, resign or be disqualified, unwilling or unable to serve as such co-executor then the others shall continue as co-executors or sole executor as the case may be. In the event my husband shall predecease me, I give and devise the same to my children to have and to hold as their property absolutely.
