

# Last Will and Testament<sup>1131</sup>

I, PAUL J. GAMBLE, a resident of Shelby County, State of Alabama, and over the age of nineteen (19) years, being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make and publish this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, revoking all former wills and codicils which may have been made by me at any time heretofore.

## ITEM I

I hereby direct that all of my debts, my funeral expenses, the expenses of my last illness and the costs of administration of my estate be paid as soon as practicable after my death.


## ITEM II

I hereby will, devise, and bequeath all property which may be mine at the time of my death, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to my beloved wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE, to be hers absolutely, to have and to hold, in fee simple forever, if she be living at the time of my death.

## ITEM III

In the event that the death of my said wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE, should occur prior to my death, or simultaneously with the time of my death, I will, devise, and bequeath all property which may be mine at the time of my death, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to

my children, KATHY ANNE GAMBLE and MARK JAMES GAMBLE, and any other child or children of mine, hereafter born or adopted by me, share and share alike, per stirpes, to be theirs absolutely, to have and to hold, in fee simple forever.

ITEM IV

In the event my said wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE, should predecease me, or should we die simultaneously, I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter, KATHY ANNE GAMBLE, as Guardian and Trustee for each and any of my children who may be a minor, or under legal disability at the time of my death. I direct that the said Guardian and Trustee shall convert my estate into cash and place the same in a bank, with interest to be drawn, and said money spent only as needed for the support, maintenance and education of said minor child or children until that child attains the age of nineteen (19) years, at which time each child shall be paid his or her equal share of my estate. I hereby declare, however, that my said Guardian and Trustee herein named shall not be required to make or file any inventory, settlement, or report to any court for their actions, nor give bond for the performance of their duties as Guardian and Trustee of said minor child or children.

ITEM V

I hereby nominate and appoint my wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE, as Executrix of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and I hereby declare that she shall not be required to make or file any inventory, settlement or report to any court for her actions, nor give bond for the performance of her duties hereunder as Executrix of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT. I hereby grant to and vest in my said Executrix full power and authority to continue the operation of any business activity in which I may be engaged at the time of my death,

together with full power and authority to sell, at private sale, and to convey, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise alienate any or all of the assets of my estate, on such terms as she deems to be proper without the order of any court, it being my purpose and intention to grant to my said Executrix or Alternate Executrix all of the powers over my said property and estate that I am capable of granting to them as such Executrix and Alternate Executrix, all without the order or approval of any court. In the event that my said wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE, should not be living at the time of my death, or if she for any reason fails to serve and qualify as Executrix, I hereby nominate and appoint my daughter, KATHY ANNE GAMBLE, as Alternate Executrix of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, with all the powers, duties and exemptions granted to and vested in my said wife, GLORIA ANNE GAMBLE.
