This affidavit is given to correct the affidavit recorded in Book 233, Page 694 and 695. This affidavit also contains facts and figures that are related to the following recorded deeds which are recorded in records at Probate Office at Shelby County Courthouse, Columbiana, Alabama. They are: Deed Book 233, Page 696, 697, 698 and 699 and they all are dated January 6, 1965.

Before me, the undersigned, personally appeared Robert Samuel Harper and after being duly sworn, states as follows:

I am Robert Samuel Harper, one of five sons born to Edgar Dewey Harper. And when said Edgar Dewey Harper died intestate in Shelby County, Alabama on November 27, 1951, he left the following named wife and the following named children who were over twenty-one (21) years of age, and were not under any disability, Viz: Wife, E. Louise Harper, sons, Thomas F. Harper, Walter L. Harper, Robert S. Harper, Clyde W. Harper and daughter, Mary Elizabeth Harper Norton. There was one deceased son named Roy Edwin Harper, who was born on January 20, 1923 and died from drowning on April 19, 1932. There was also at the time of Edgar Dewey Harper's death, November 27, 1951, a daughter named Edna Mae Harper Bostick Kirkendoll who was allowed to be adopted by a dear friend of our mother's named Mildred Bostick in or about 1938. This daughter of Edgar Dewey Harper, named Edna Mae Harper Bostick Kirkendoll, after being adopted, more or less faded from our lives. But after 48 years of much searching by myself and my brothers and the sister listed earlier, Mary Elizabeth Harper Norton, we were reunited with this adopted sister, Edna Mae. In reference to this fact, please refer to the Birmingham News on July 22, 1985 on Page 4A.

The said Edgar Dewey Harper had been previously married to Sally Mae Moore Harper. However, she died intestate in Jefferson County, Alabama, in February 1937.

This Statement of Facts is executed to correct errors in a statement given by E. Louise Wilder on January 6, 1965 to Attorney W. W. Conwell. The description of the said property is as follows:

From the Northwest corner of the Northwest one quarter of the Northeast one quarter of Section Twenty-Five (25), Township Nineteen South (19-S), and Range One (1), West go South on the West border of the above said quarter-quarter section a distance of some three hundred and seventy-eight feet (378 Ft.) to the right of way as presently located, of Highway No. 280

or the Florida Short Route, running from Childersburg, Alabama to Birmingham, Alabama. Thence go Eastward along the right of way of said 280 Highway one hundred and five feet (105 Ft.) for a point of beginning. From this point of beginning go Eastward one hundred and fifty feet (150 Ft.) thence North two hundred and ten feet (210 Ft.) thence West one hundred and fifty feet (150 Ft.) thence South two hundred and ten feet (210 Ft.) to the point of beginning, comprising one acre of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Commence at the Northwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 25, Twonship 19 South, Range 1 West, go South from the said point of beginning on the West quarter of the above said quarter-quarter section a distance of one hundred and sixty-eight feet (168 Ft.). Thence East two hundred and fifty-five feet (255 Ft.), thence North approximately one hundred and sixty-eight feet (168 Ft.) to the North border of said quarter-quarter section and thence West to the point of beginning, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
