ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION



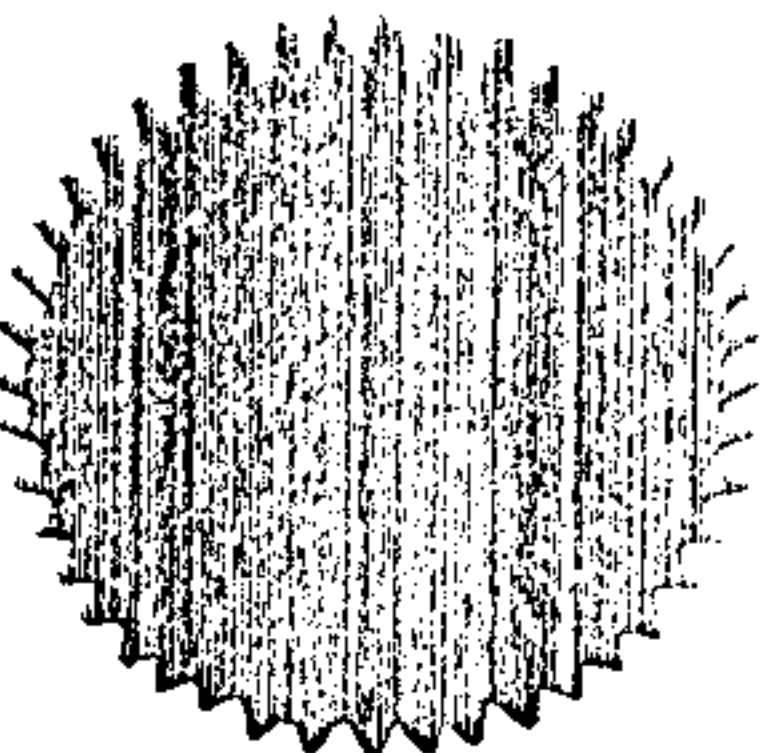
