Before me, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Doyle Yessick, who, first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Doyle Yessick. I am over the age of 19 years and am a resident of Alabaster, Shelby County, Alabama. I own the following described real estate in joint tenancy with my wife, Josephine K. Yessick:

A tract of land located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 3 West; thence Westerly along the South line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 400 feet to the point of beginning of tract of land herein described; thence continue along the last mentioned course 200 feet; thence 88 deg. 26 min. right, Northerly and parallel to the East line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 635.58 feet; thence 91 deg. 29 min. right, 200 feet; thence 88 deg. 26 min. right 635.87 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

On April 15, 1968, when my wife and I purchased this land, we executed a note and mortgage to the Grantors, W.J. Lewis and Bessie H. Lewis, in the amount of \$1,350.00. The mortgage is recorded in Mortgage Book 308, page 726, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. I do not have the original or a copy of the mortgage or note. It has come to my attention that the mortgage has not been marked satisfied on the records.

I know that we paid this note in full. It was a short term note for a small amount of money. I have made a diligent search of my records, and have found that the latest income tax return showing a payment of mortgage interest was in 1971. Returns for 1972, and subsequent years show no interest payments. I have had no contact whatsoever with Mr. or Mrs. Lewis since before 1972. They have never notified me in any way that any balance is still owed on this indebtedness. I do not know their current whereabouts.
