KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, George A. Wood, Jr., a resident citizen of Jefferson County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years and of sound mind and memory do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills or Codicils by me at any time heretofore made.

ITEM I: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses, including the expenses of my last illness, be paid as soon after my decease as practical.

ITEM II: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, of every kind and nature, both real and personal, and wheresoever situated, of which I die seised or possessed, or over which I have power of disposition, or any interest whatsoever, all diamonds and jewelry, life insurance policies on my life, I hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter, Shirley Dianne Wood Addison, per stirpes.

ITEM III: I hereby constitute and appoint William Robert Johnson, of Montgomery, Alabama, as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. If William Robert Johnson does not survive me, or fails to qualify, or having qualified fails to complete the administration of my estate, then I hereby constitute and appoint Barbara Chessier Johnson, as Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. Neither personal representative named herein shall be required to give any bond or to file any inventory or appraisal of my estate in any Court, though my personal representatives shall keep proper records of account and permit the examination thereof by any interested party during reasonable hours.

To sell, convey, exchange, lease for a period beyond the termination of the administration of my estate, or for a less period, improve, borrow on the security of, encumber or otherwise dispose of, all or any part of my estate, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as my said personal representative may approve, and to invest and reinvest my estate and the proceeds of sale of any portion thereof in such loans, stocks, bonds or other securities, mortgages, common trust funds, or other property as my said personal representative may consider suitable, whether or not a so-called "legal" investment of trust funds, and to change investments and to make new investments from time to time as to my said personal representative may seem necessary or desirable. My said personal representative shall be free from the control and supervision of the Probate Court or any other Court in the exercise of the foregoing provisions.
