I have been familiar with the occupation, use and possession of the following described land for more than 45 years, to-wit:

That part of the West 210 feet of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 1 East lying South of the North 960 feet thereof, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

The above described property is presently owned by my son, Frank W. Elliott. My husband, Frank C. Elliott, and I owned the property before conveying it to the said Frank W. Elliott.

We occupied the above property, fencing it in, along with other property. I know that since Mr. Elliott purchased said property he has used the same, under fence, built a poultry house on a part of it and it was always, without question, considered to be the Elliott property since I have been familiar with the same.

The present owner has assessed said property for taxes and paid taxes on the same for each and every year that he has owned the same; no other person, firm or corporation has paid taxes on said property other than the present owner and his predecessor in title.

Since the time that I first knew the land it has been owned by the present owner and his predecessors in title and has been occupied by him actually, exclusively, openly, notoriously, hostilely and continuously and I have never heard the title of the present owner or his predecessors in title questioned in any way.
