ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation and acting as incorporator of said corporation under the Code of Alabama, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is DAVIDSON ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose of purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To do any and all acts and things legally authorized to be done by a business corporation in the State of Alabama.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is One Thousand (1000) shares, of a par value of \$1.00 per share, all of which has been subscribed for by Robert Carl Davidson, Jr.

FIFTH: There shall be one (1) director constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation, to be elected by the stockholders, and the internal affairs of the corporation shall be governed by said board of directors.
