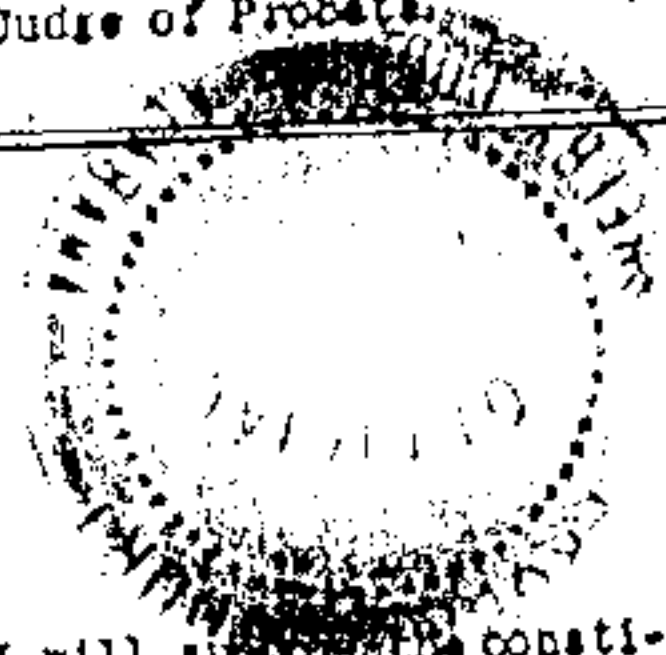
OATH OF OFFICE
