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- (k) I devise to KIMBERLY JOE JORDON the dining room furniture.

ITEM TWO

I hereby designate my wife, MARCELL M. DUKES, as executrix. I direct that the executrix shall not be required to give bond or to file any inventory or appraisal of my estate in any court, though she shall make out and keep an inventory and shall exhibit the same to any party in interest at any reasonable time; and I direct that she shall be free from the control and supervision of any court. If MARCELL M. DUKES should fail or cease to serve as executrix hereunder, then I designate and appoint ETHEL P. CRAIG as successor executrix. My successor executrix shall have all the rights, powers, duties, responsibilities and exemptions as are herein conferred upon the original executrix.

During the administration of my estate, I hereby vest in my executrix full power to sell, convey, exchange, lease for a period beyond the termination of the administration of my estate or for a less period, improve, borrow on the security of, encumber of otherwise dispose of my estate in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as my executrix may approve and to

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invest and reinvest the assets of my estate and the proceeds of sale or any portion thereof in such loans, bonds, stocks or other securities, mortgages, common trust funds or other property as she may consider suitable without regard to any statutory or constitutional limitation and to change and to make new investments from time to time as may seem necessary or desirable.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, JOHN LEE DUKES, the testator, sign my name to this instrument this 14 day of 1986, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my last will and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am nineteen years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
