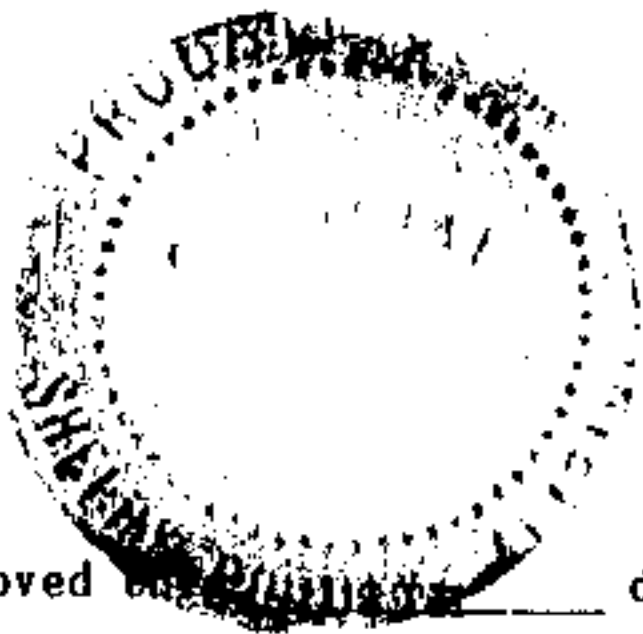
Know All Men By These Presents
