POWER OF ATTORNEY

its true and lawful Attorney(s)-in-Fact, with full power and authority for and on behalf of the company as surety, to execute and deliver and affix the seal of the company thereto if a seal is required, bonds, undertakings, recognizances or other written obligations in the nature thereof, (excluding: Criminal Bonds or recognizances, Supersedeas Bonds of any kind, Defendants Court Bonds in Judicial Proceedings, Community Administration Bonds, Contractors Bid, Performance, Payment and Completion Bonds; Motor Fuel Distributors Bonds; Consignee and Consignor Bonds) as follows:

ALL WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED AN AGGREGATE OF
TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$250,000) DOLLARS FOR ANY SINGULAR OBLIGATION.

REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF INSTRUMENTS ISSUED FOR THE OBLIGATION, and to bind LAWYERS SURETY CORPORATION OF Dallas, Texas, thereby, and all of the acts of said Attorneys-in-Fact, pursuant to these presents, are hereby ratified and confirmed. This appointment is made under and by authority of the following provisions of the By-Laws of the company, which are now in full force and effect:

Article 5, Section A. The Board of Directors shall have the management of the business of the company, and in addition to the powers and authorities by these By-Laws expressly conferred upon them, may exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things, as may be exercised or done by the corporation.

Article 5, Section 6. The Board of Directors may appoint additional officers and agents to perform such duties. This Power of Attorney is signed and sealed by facsimile under and by the authority of the following resolutions adopted by the Board of Directors of LAWYERS SURETY CORPORATION of Dallas, Texas at a meeting duly held on January 29, 1972.

RESOLVED that the PRESIDENT, any Vice-President, or Assistant Vice-President, in conjunction with the Secretary or any Assistant Secretary, may appoint attorneys-in-fact or agents with authority as defined or limited in the instrument evidencing the appointment in each case for and on behalf of the company to execute and deliver and affix the seal of the company to bonds, undertakings, recognizances, and suretyship obligations of all kinds; and said officers may remove any such attorney-in-fact or agent and revoke any power of attorney previously granted to such person.

RESOLVED FURTHER that any bond, undertaking, recognizances, or suretyship obligation shall be valid and binding upon the company (i) when signed and sealed by the President, any Vice-President, or Assistant Vice-President; or (ii) when duly executed and sealed (if a seal be required) by one or more attorneys-in-fact or agents pursuant to and within the limits of the authority evidenced by the power of attorney issued by the company to such person or persons.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the signature of any authorized officers and the seal of the company may be affixed by facsimile to any power of attorney or certificate thereof authorizing the execution and delivery of any bond, undertaking, recognizance or other suretyship obligations of the company; and such signature and seal when so used shall have the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
