ORDER GRANTING JUDGMENT AND EXCEPTING FROM DISCHARGE

The complaint of Brent Thornley, Trustee, for the collection of a debt notwithstanding bankruptcy having been duly set for hearing on proper service of Summons and Complaint, and the matter coming on to be heard upon the appearance of the parties and attorneys of record, and the parties agreeing in open court by and through their attorneys of record to settle and compromise this matter, the Court finds that relief should be granted the plaintiff and judgment rendered and for good cause shown.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 1. That the plaintiff, Brent Thornley, Trustee, recover of the defendants, Lesa Cagle and Charles Hugh McGregor, the sum of One Hundred Forty Five Thousand and No/100 (\$145,000.00) Dollars, and the sum of One Hundred Twenty and No/100 (\$120.00) Dollars costs of court, the said debt shall be excepted from discharge of the defendants, Lesa Cagle & Charles Hugh McGregor, under Section 523(a)(2).
- 2. It is further ordered that the full judgment of \$145,000.00 may be satisfied in full by the payment of the sum of \$100,000.00 with interest at 10% per annum from date. Such \$100,000.00 to be paid as follows:
 - (a) JASPER PROPERTY. A deed to the Jasper property will be executed by the defendant, Charles Hugh McGregor, to Brent Thornley, Trustec, within three days. McGregor will be responsible for the \$1,165.00 monthly payment until the property is sold (McGregor will collect rent during the pending sale). After the property is sold, the net proceeds realized, will be credited on the \$100,000.00.

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- (b) DEFICIENCY. The deficiency will be paid within thirty days or in monthly installments due one month after deficiency determined in (a) above, plus 10% per annum, over a period of two and one-half years. Such deficiency will be secured by a recorded third mortgage to be given by McGregor on his will be secured by a recorded third mortgage to be given by McGregor on his Shelby County home. McGregor will pay current monthly first and second mortgage payments.
- (c) DEFAULT. In the event of failure to comply with all the provisions for the payment of the \$100,000.00, then the full nondischargeable judgment of \$145,000.00, with interest at the legal rate of interest from date would be due and payable and execution may issue forthwith.
- 3. It is further ordered by the Court that payment of the proceeds of the judgment and costs herein shall be made directly to attorney(s) of record for the plaintiff and that, upon receipt thereof, such attorney(s) will satisfy said judgment of record of this Court. FURTHER, no execution and no Certificate of Judgment shall be issued pending the agreed satisfaction of such judgment.
