The Credit Agreement provides for finance charges to be computed on the unpaid balance outstanding from time to time under the Credit Agreement at an adjustable annual percentage rate. The annual percentage rate may be increased or decreased on the first day of each billing cycle based on changes in the AmSouth Prime Rate. The "AmSouth Prime Rate" is the rate of interest designated by AmSouth Bank N.A. From time to time as its "prime rate." The AmSouth Prime Rate is one of the base rates AmSouth Bank N.A. establishes from time to time for lending purposes and it is not necessarily the best or lowest rate offered by AmSouth Bank N.A.
