AN ALABAMA CORPORATION

ARTICLE ONE .

NAME

The name of the Corporation is Faith House, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

The term of existance of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized in order to provide a safe shelter for those abused parents and their children, and also to provide these abused parents and their children referral to the appropriate agency of which they will want to go for whatever help they will/might need.

The Corporation is also organized in order to engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE FOUR

AMMENDMENTS

The Executive Board of Directors vote on ammendments adopted into the articles of Incorporation. Date of new ammendments to the Atticles of Incorporation is April 1, 1989

ARTICLE FIVE

A VOLUNTEER EXECUTIVE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There will be no pay for those serving on the Executive Board of Directors. All serving on the Executive Board of Directors will be on a volunteer basis from term to term.

ARTICLE SIX

ELECTING AND VOTING OF EXECUTIVE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Each person serving on the Executive Board of Directors at the end of term will select two persons to be their successor. Those contributers to Faith House, Inc. will then vote one of these persons to the Executive Board of Directors. The Executive Board of Directors will then vote who they want as officers

ARTICLE SEVEN

MINUTES

The minutes to each meeting will be signed by the secretary and also by the president.

ARTICLE EIGHT

CONTRACTS, LOANS, CHECKS, AND DEPOSITS

CONTRACTS: The board of directors may authorize any officer of officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

LOANS: No loans shall be contracted on behalf of the corporation, and no evidences of indebtedness shall be insured in its name unless authorized by a resolution of the board of directors. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

CHECKS, DRAFTS, ETC.: All checks, drafts or other orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the board of directors.

DEPOSITS: All funds of the corporation not otherwise employed shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositaries as the board of directors may select.

ARTICLE NINE

FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin on the 1st day of January and end on the 31st day of December of each year.

ARTICLE TEN

TERMS OF OFFICE

The terms of office will be over a period of two (2) years (STAGERING).

ARTICLE ELEVEN

DIRECTORS
