(formerly known as Shelby State Bank, an Alabama corporation), ("First Alabama"), which said mortgage is recorded in Mortgage Book 439, Page 499, in said Probate Office; and,

WHEREAS, First Alabama foreclosed the said mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 439, Page 499, in said Probate Office on May 6, 1988, as reflected in Mortgage Foreclosure Deed dated May 7, 1988, recorded in Book 185, Page 540, in said Probate Office; and,

WHEREAS, William E. Morrow and wife, Alice W. Morrow ("Morrow") requested that Colonial transfer, assign, set over and deliver unto them Colonial's right to redeem the said real property, arising out of and resulting from the foreclosure by First Alabama of its said mortgage; and,

WHEREAS, Colonial desires to transfer, assign, set over and deliver to Morrow its right to redeem said real property from said foreclosure sale,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid by Colonial and Morrow, each to the other, the receipt, adequacy and sufficiency whereof are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Morrow, their heirs, personal representatives and assigns, forever.
