Whereas Edmund King, the City Surveyor
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Benton in Montana
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edmund King
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the first half of the Month March, for sections thirteen in Township twenty one of range fifteen, that is to say, the
District of Fort Benton and State of Montana containing forty eight acres and forty six hundredths of an acre

according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

chased by the said Edmund King,

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Edmund King and his
heirs
the said tract above described, To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Edmund King
and his heirs and assigns forever.
