## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FRED JOHNSON & ASSOCIATES, P. C.

Revised Alabama Professional Pursuant the to Corporation Act (Act No. 83-514, Regular Session Legislature amendatory thereof, 1983) and Alabama act οf any supplementary thereto or substituted therefor (hereinafter called the "Act") and for the purpose of forming a professional corporation under the Act in compliance with (to the extent not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act) the Alabama Business Corporation Act, the undersigned individual sole incorporator, being of the age of twenty-one years or more and who holds a license to engage in the practice of public accounting in the State of Alabama, does hereby organize the Professional Corporation under the name #set forth below, becomes a shareholder thereof and does hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation, and, upon the making and filing for record of these Articles of Incorporation in the office of the Judge of Probate of 3 Jefferson County, Alabama, this Professional Corporation shall be deemed to be in existence.

FIRST: The name of the Professional Corporation shall be Fred Johnson & Associates, P. C. (hereinafter called the "P. C.").

SECOND: The Professional Corporation shall have perpetual duration.
