I, JOSEPH H. DICKERT, of 4525 Cahaba River Road, Birmingham, Alabama 35243, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills or testamentary dispositions which might have been made by me at any time heretofore:

FIRST: I will and direct that my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as is convenient.

SECOND: I will, devise, and bequeath all of my property and estate, of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease as follows:

A. I will and devise all of my right, title, and interest in the Mitchell Family cemetery plot in Limestone County, Alabama to my daughter, LAURA D. SMITH, per stirpes.

B. I will and devise all of my right, title, and interest in any real property located in Shelby County, Alabama, of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease, to my daughter, LAURA D. SMITH, per stirpes.

C. In the event my wife, WANDA B. DICKERT, survives me, I will, devise, and bequeath unto her all of the remainder and residue of my property and estate, of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease.

D. In the event that the death of my said wife, WANDA B. DICKERT, shall occur prior to my death, or at approximately the same time as a result of a common disaster or calamity, I will,

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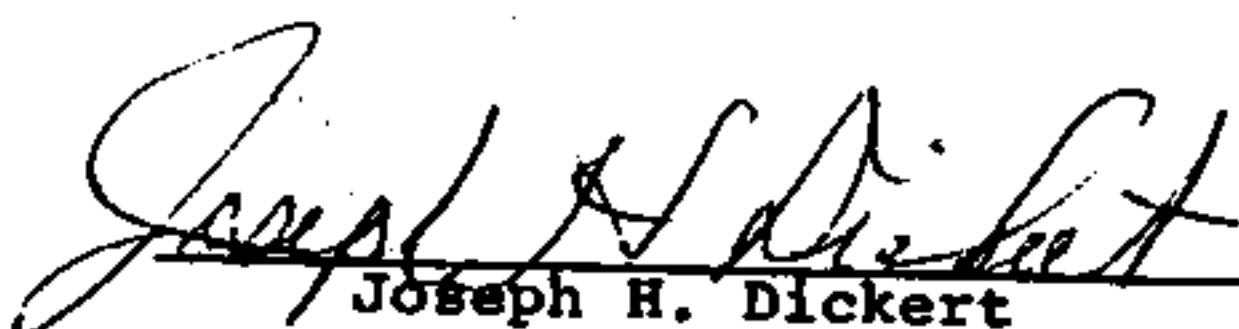

devise, and bequeath all of the remainder and residue of my property and estate, of every kind and character, real, personal, or mixed, wheresoever situate, of which I may die seized and possessed or to which I may be entitled at the time of my decease to my daughter, LAURA D. SMITH, per stirpes.

THIRD: I nominate and appoint my daughter, LAURA D. SMITH, to be the Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament. It is my will and desire that my Executrix shall not be required to give any bond or security for the performance of her duties as such Executrix, or to account to any court for her acts and doings as such Executrix, and that she is hereby expressly exempted from filing an inventory or making any report of final settlement of my estate. Said Executrix shall have full power, without the necessity for any order from any court, to sell (for payment of debts and all other purposes), exchange, convey, lease, invest, reinvest, mortgage or encumber all or any portion of my estate in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as she may approve.

I, JOSEPH H. DICKERT, the testator, sign my name to this instrument this 31 day of May, 1988, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and that I sign it willingly, that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am eighteen years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.
