"Joe" Vizzina, d/b/a Associated Wholesalers of Alabama, Inc., and fix compensatory damages in the amount of \$6,840.00 based on our finding(s) that the defendant has  $\underline{X}$  violated the Motor Vehicle Information and Costs Savings Act; X perpetrated legal fraud \_\_\_ breached his contract with plaintiff Punitive damages X are, M are not, Awarded in the amount of \$10,000.00"; and taxing costs against the defendant.

It is further ORDERED that the defendant pay direct to the attorneys of record for the plaintiff the proceeds of the judgment and costs recovered herein by the plaintiff, and that upon receipt thereof, the attorneys of record for the plaintiff will satisfy said judgment on the records of this court.
