KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Vivian L. Wesley, now residing at 1825 Clifton Road, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia 30029, do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint Hooper C. Wesley, now residing in Fulton County, Georgia, my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit.

To ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends, annuities, employee benefits, insurance benefits and demands whatsoever as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, payable or belonging to me and have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name or otherwise, and to compromise and agree for the same and give acquittances or other sufficient discharges and releases.

For me and in my name, to make, execute and deliver, to bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive and take lands and all or any interest in property, and all deeds and other assurances, in the law therefor, and to lease, let, demise, bargain, sell, release, convey, mortgage and hypothecate lands, and all or any interest in property upon such terms and conditions and under such covenants as she shall think fit.

Also to bargain and agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise, choses in action and other property in possession or in action, and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of whatsoever nature and kind.

And also for me and in my name, and as my act and deed, to sign, seal, execute, deliver and acknowledge such deeds, leases, mortgages, hypothecations, bills, bonds, notes, receipts, evidence of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgage, judgments and other debts and such other instruments in writing of whatsoever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises.
