JUDGMENT

This matter was tried on the 8th day of May, 1989. Present:
Anita D. McKeithen, counsel for petitioner; and Diehlmann C. Bernhardt,
Attorney at Law appointed by the Court to represent the defendant.
Considering the testimony introduced by petitioner, and the report under
oath submitted by the physician appointed by the Court to examine the

the reasons this day orally assigned:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1. The defendant, Suzanne Ochs Landry, is interdicted and declared
and incompetent, who is incapable of taking care of her person and of
administering her estate;
2. Maxine J. Ochs is appointed curatrix of the interdict and letters
of curatorship are ordered to be issued to her after she has complied with
all requirements of law;
3. William Paul Ochs, Jr. is appointed undercurator of the interdict.
