JUDGEMENT

On May 25, 1989 came on to be heard the petition of the Guardians in succession of the person and estate of Bobby Lee Jackson against the former Guardian of the ward's estate, Doyle H. Jackson and his Surety, United Fidelity and Guaranty Company (USF&G). States Petitioners appeared by their attorney, Frank A. Poff, Jr. and by Betty L. Kasic, individually. The Surety, USF&G appeared by Kemp, Duckett & Hopkins by Randolph B. Hopkins. The former guardian, Doyle H. Jackson appeared not and continues to be in default although being duly notified of the initial proceeding held herein. After full consideration of the sworn testimony of Betty L. Kasic, exhibits, argument of counsel and other matters and things properly before this court, the court does hereby find:

- 1. The successor guardians have amended and reduced their claim down to the sum of \$5,500.00. This sum represents:
- A. \$3,959.89 which was in account number 09-28-002939 in the Jefferson Federal Savings and Loan Association, Birmingham, Alabama. These funds were property of the estate of Bobby Lee Jackson which were obtained by Doyle H. Jackson and which he has failed to remit to the successor guardians of the estate herein.
- B. \$1,636.00 which represents six social security checks which were received by Doyle H. Jackson but were not remitted by him to Faye Schubert (former guardian of the person of Bobby Lee Jackson) or to the successor guardians.

- C. The balance represents a fair estimate of the amount of interest which would have been earned on the funds of the estate had they been properly invested at all times in an interest bearing account. There is no record of the existence of a properly established bank account for a period of some 19 months between October 25, 1985 and May 14, 1987.
- 2. The guardians in succession moved in open court for joint and several judgment against USF&G and Doyle H. Jackson in the sum of \$5,500.00. This motion was granted by the court. Thereafter, USF&G immediately satisfied the judgment in full by delivering the sum of \$5,500.00 to the successor guardians and their attorney. Upon satisfaction in full of the judgment, USF&G moved in open court for judgment over and against Doyle H. Jackson. This motion was also granted by the court.
- 3. USF&G has now fulfilled all of its obligations under the bond posted by the former guardian, Doyle H. Jackson and USF&G should be discharged, released and acquitted of and from any and all further obligations and duties pursuant to said bond.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that USF&G should be and it is hereby released, discharged and acquitted of and from any and all obligations and duties created by the surety bond posted by Doyle H. Jackson as guardian of the estate herein.

IT IS FURTHER CONSIDERED ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that USF&G should be and it is hereby granted judgment over and against Doyle H. Jackson in the sum of \$5,500.00 plus interest at the rate of 10% per annum from May 25, 1989 until paid for all of which execution and garnishment shall issue forthwith.
