One Lot situated in the Town of Calera, Alabama, and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East right of way line of Montgomery Avenue, now known as the Montgomery and Birmingham Highway, at a point 150 feet South from the southwest corner of the lot formerly known as the R.C. Scroggins lot, and which point is also 75 feet South from the southwest corner of the lot heretofore sold to W.R. Doak, and which said point of beginning is also described as commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot 3, according to the survey division and agreement in the division of the lands belonging to the South and North Alabama Railroad Company, Jesse Kelley, E.A.
