 - (1v) whose family income exceeds 115% (100% in the case of family size of less than 3 persons) of applicable median family income (140% for a family) (120% in the case of family size of less than 3 persons in a targeted area residence), all as provided in Section 143(f) and (i)(2) of the internal Revenue Code; or
- (b) Borrower ("Mortgagor") fails to occupy the property described in the Mortgage without Lender's ("Mortgagee's") prior written consent; or
- (c) Borrower ("Mortgagor") omits or misrepresents a material fact in an application for this mortgage.
