FINAL ORDER AND JUDGMENT

The above adversary proceeding was tried on October 3, and October 16, 1989. MacBeth Wagnon, Esquire, and J. David Pugh, Esquire, represented the Plaintiff; and Randy A. Dempsey, Esquire and F. Wade Steed, Esquire, represented the Debtor/Defendant.

On the basis of the findings of fact and conclusions of law stated orally and recorded in open court following the close of evidence, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. JUDGMENT is rendered for the Debtor/Defendant on that aspect of the Complaint seeking to except from Debtor's discharge damages allegedly incurred in the course of his dealings with Micro Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of a computer supplement or system known as IDS.

2. That the Plaintiff, International Order of Foresters, Inc., have and recover of the Debtor/Defendant, Freddy Allen Moore, the sum of \$10,000.00 on that aspect of the Plaintiff's Complaint which sought exception from the Debtor's discharge for that sum alleged to have been embezzled from International Order of Foresters. This Judgment is hereby excepted from the discharge of the Debtor granted by this court on July 18, 1989 (Proceeding Number 20 in the main bankruptcy file numbered 89-05161).

It is further ORDERED that in the event of the Defendant's failure to pay this judgment in accordance with its terms, Plaintiff shall have the right of all legal process for the full satisfaction and enforcement of this judgment.

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It is further ORDERED by the court that payment of the proceeds of the judgment and costs herein may be made directly to the attorney of record for the Plaintiff and that, upon receipt thereof, such attorney will satisfy said judgment on the records of this court.

Plaintiff's Motion to Amend Objection to Discharge filed in open court on October 16, 1989 (Proceeding Number 22) is DENIED as untimely filed.

The file in this adversary proceeding may now be closed.
