List of lands, in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, within the six mile limits, granted to the State of Alabama, by the act of Congress approved the 3d of June 1856, entitled "an act granting public lands in alternate sections to the State of Alabama to aid in the construction of certain Rail Roads in said State." Being the vacant and unappropriated lands in the alternate sections designated as odd numbers for six sections in width on each side of the Rail Road from Selma to Gadsden in said State."
