KNOWS ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

That pursuant to a certain Management Agreement dated as of February 7, 1989 ("Management Agreement"), among the Federal Home Loan Bank Board ("FHLBB"), and the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corporation ("FSLIC") and the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation ("FDIC"), the FDIC agreed to act as Manager for the FSLIC in its capacity as conservator and receiver of certain savings and loan associations. Pursuant to the Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery, and Enforcement Act of 1989 ("FIRREA"), the FSLIC was abolished as of the date of enactment of the FIRREA, and the Resolution Trust Corporation ("RTC") was created. By Resolutions issued by the Board of Directors of the RTC and the FDIC, dated as of August 9, 1989, the RTC and the FDIC agreed that the RTC would succeed to and assume the rights and obligations of FSLIC and the FHLBB under the Management Agreement. The rights and obligations of both parties continue in full force and effect until terminated by mutual agreement of the Boards of Directors of the FDIC and the RTC.

That by Order issued under delegated authority of the Director of Office of Thrift Supervision ("OTS") dated as of November 1, 1989, the RTC was appointed conservator of First Louisiana Federal Savings Bank, F.A., a newly organized federal savings association, having its principal place of business in Lafayette, Louisiana, (hereinafter respectively the "Conservator" and the "Association"), whose accounts are insured by the FDIC through the Savings Association Insurance Fund.

THEREFORE, the Resolution Trust Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under an act of Congress, for the purpose of facilitating the conservation, preservation and protection of the Association's assets, property and liabilities, does hereby authorize and empower Jean S. Porter as its Attorney in Fact to execute, acknowledge and deliver in the name of the Manager any instrument necessary for any purpose including, but not limited to, any and all checks, drafts, bills of exchange, or other evidences of indebtedness; stock, bonds, notes, trust documents, debentures or securities, whether held as owner, pledgee or assignee; indemnity agreements, surety bonds, deeds, releases and any other agreements, instruments or documents associated with normal operations of the Association or necessary to effectuate the intent and purpose of the Management Agreement.

This Appointment and Power of Attorney shall be effective as of November 7, 1989, and continue until such time as this Appointment and Power of Attorney has been terminated by the Board of Directors of the RTC or by an official of the RTC authorized to do so by its Board of Directors.
