Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North East quarter of the South West quarter, the West half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty, the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Nineteen, the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty, and the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Twenty Nine, in Township Twenty one, of Range Three West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Two Hundred and Thirty Seven acres and Sixty hundredths of an acre
