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Last Will and Testament

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, LETA J. GLASSCOCK, residing and being domiciled in Bexar County, Texas, hereby revoke all previous Wills and Codicils made by me, and hereby make, declare and publish this, my Last Will.

ITEM I

EXECUTORSHIP

A. EXECUTOR. I appoint GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK, Independent Executrix of this Will and of my Estate. If GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK should fail or cease to serve as an Executrix for any reason, then I appoint MARYANN DELMER as Independent Executrix of this Will and of my Estate. If MARYANN DELMER should fail or cease to serve as Executrix for any reason, then I appoint LINDA LYONS BEADLE, as Independent Executrix of this Will and of my Estate. My Independent Executrix, whether original, substitute or successor, is herein called Executor.

B. BOND. No Executor shall be required to furnish bond or any other security.

C. POWERS. Whether or not my Estate is indebted to any person, I give unto my Executor from the date of granting of letters until my Estate has been entirely distributed the same rights, powers, authorities, privileges and discretions with reference to the control, management and disposition of my Estate that are given to Trustees by the provisions of the Texas Trust

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Code (Article 7425b, V.A.C.S., Texas), in addition to all other powers given to Independent Executors by law.

D. DEBTS AND TAXES. I direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as practicable after my death. I further direct that my Executor pay out of my residuary Estate, without apportionment, all estate, inheritance, succession and other taxes assessed by reason of my death by the Government of the United States or any State or Territory thereof, or by any foreign government or political subdivision thereof, in respect to all property required to be included in my gross Estate for estate or like tax purposes by any such government, whether the same passes under this Will or otherwise, including property over which I have power of appointment, without contribution by any recipient of any such property.

E. TIME AND METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION. I direct my Executor to distribute my Estate as soon as possible after my death and my Executor is authorized to make such distribution in cash or in kind or partly in cash and partly in kind, and my Executor is further authorized to distribute my Estate subject to any and all indebtednesses incurred by me or by my Executor which in the opinion of my Executor need not first be paid, and subject to any and all mortgages, deeds of trust or other liens created by me or by my Executor. My Executor is authorized to begin distribution of income (or principal) from my Estate exactly as if any trust created by Item II of this Will had been established at the time of my death.


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F. LIMITATION OF COURT SUPERVISION. I direct that no other action shall be had in the County Court in relation to the settlement of my Estate than the probating and recording of my Last Will and the return of an inventory, appraisement and list of claims of my Estate.

ITEM II

DISPOSITION OF ESTATE: CONTINGENT TRUST

A. DISPOSITION OF ESTATE. I devise and bequeath my entire Estate, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, to my daughter, GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK, to be hers absolutely if she shall survive me. If my daughter, GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK, shall not survive me, then I devise and bequeath my entire Estate to the children of: COLETTE GLASSCOCK BLAKEY, STANLEY W. GLASSCOCK and GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK, or the survivor or survivors of them, share and share alike.

B. CONTINGENT TRUST: Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph A of this Item II, if at the time of my death any beneficiary of mine is less than thirty-five (35) years of age and is entitled to receive any portion of my Estate according to Paragraph A of this Item II, then my Executor, acting as Trustee, shall not distribute such beneficiary's share as provided in such Paragraph A, but shall hold the same in trust until the first of the following events occurs: (a) my beneficiary attains the age of 35 years; (b) the death of my beneficiary; at which time the trust hereby created shall terminate and the principal and undistributed income thereof shall be distributed to such of my beneficiaries as shall be living at the time of termination of such trust. As to any distribution made in accordance with the provisions hereof, my


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Executrix may in her discretion make such distribution to any such person in any one or more of the following ways: (1) to any such person directly; (2) to the guardian, committee, conservator or other similar official of a minor or incapacitated person; (3) to a custodian for such person designated by my Executor under the Texas Uniform Gifts to Minors Act or other similar statute; (4) to a relative of a minor or incapacitated person to be expended by such relative for the care, support, maintenance, education or comfort of such person; and (5) by expending the same directly for the care, support, maintenance, education or comfort of any such person.

I have deliberately made no provision herein for the benefit of my children other than GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK, not because of any lack of love or affection, but because they have ample property of their own.

I have confidence that my daughter GRETCHEN GLASSCOCK understands my property and is fully competent and able to manage it.

ITEM III

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

A. INVALID PROVISIONS. if any part of this Will (or any trust hereby created) shall be invalid, illegal, or inoperative, for any reason, it is my intention that the remaining parts, so far as possible and reasonable, shall be effective and fully operative. My Executor may seek and obtain Court instructions for the purpose of carrying out as nearly as may be possible the intention of this Will as shown by the terms hereof, including any term held invalid, illegal or inoperative.

B. HEADINGS. The headings which have been used throughout this Will have been inserted for administrative convenience only and do not constitute matter to be construed in interpreting this Will.
