NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH, That I, Philip J. Sullivan, District Director of Internal Revenue at Birmingham, Alabama, through my delegate, Carroll W. Cooper (hereinafter referred to as the District Director), charged by law with the duty of collecting and enforcing the collection of internal revenue taxes due to the United States, and charged with the assessment hereinbefore stated, do pursuant to the provisions of section 6325 (d)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, subordinate the aforesaid tax lien, in the amount heretofore state to the instrument herein described as Purchase Money Mortgage in favor of Transport Services of Indiana, Inc., Camel, Indiana in the amount of \$50,000.00., saving and reserving, however, the force and effect of said tax lien against and upon all other property or rights to property to which said lien is attached, wheres [REDACTED] situated.
