

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

MARVIN JOHNSON AUTO SERVICE, INC.

The undersigned as corporators, desiring to organize a body corporate under the laws of the State of Alabama, do make, sign and file this ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION as follows;

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the Corporation is MARVIN JOHNSON AUTO SERVICE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The period of its duration shall be unlimited and perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is organized is to own and operate an auto and truck repair business.

ARTICLE FOUR

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is Two Hundred (200) shares of common stock, all of the same class and with a par value of Ten and 00/100 Dollars (\$10.00) per share. The amount of the total authorized capital stock with which this corporation shall begin business shall be \$1,000.00, representing 100 shares of stock issued having been paid for in cash.

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No holder of any stock in the Corporation shall be entitled as of right to purchase or subscribe for any part of any unissued or treasury stock of the Corporation, or of any additional stock of any class to be issued by reason of any increase of the authorized capital stock of the Corporation, or bonds, certificates of indebtedness, debentures, or other securities convertible into stock of the Corporation, but any such unissued or treasury stock or any such additional authorized issue of any new stock, or any securities convertible into stock, may be issued and disposed of by the Board of Directors to such person, firms, corporations or associations and upon such terms as the Board of Directors may in its discretion determine, without offering to the stockholders then of record, or any class of stockholders, on the same terms or on any terms.

ARTICLE FIVE

The corporate power shall be exercised by the Board of Directors, except as otherwise provided by statute or by this Articles of Incorporation. In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

- (a) To make and alter the By-Laws of the Corporation, but By-Laws so made by the directors may be altered or repealed by the directors or stockholders.
- (b) To fix and determine and vary the amount of working capital of the Corporation; to determine whether any, and if any, what part of any accumulated profits shall be declared and paid as dividends; to determine the date or dates for the declaration and payment of dividends; to direct and determine the payment of dividends; to direct and determine the use and disposition of any surplus or net profits over and above the capital stock paid in.

The Corporation may, by its By-Laws, confer powers upon its Board of Directors in addition to the foregoing, addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon it by statute.

ARTICLE SIX

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 3323 Highway 31 South, Pelham, Alabama, 35124, and the name of its initial registered agent as such address is Marvin Johnson.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is Two (2) and the name and address of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify is:
