

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAVANNAH DEVELOPMENT, INC.

1. The name of the corporation is Savannah Development, Inc.
2. The period of its duration is perpetual.

3. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, including without limitation, to purchase, own, hold, develop and sell real property, improved and unimproved, or any interest therein or easement thereon; to purchase lands and subdivide the same into subdivisions or lots; to loan money upon real property and to accept secured and unsecured notes as collateral for same; to execute notes, deeds of trust, mortgages, and chattel mortgages; to enter into leases as landlord or tenants; to perform or do any act customarily performed or done by a subdivider or real property developer; to invest in and hold for investment any real property, shares of stock, bonds, government, private, or corporate; and to exchange and enter into agreements of exchange of one parcel of real property for another parcel of real property.

4. The aggregate number of shares of capital stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000 shares of common stock, par value of \$1.00 per share.

5. The location and mailing address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 6257 Victoria Drive, Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama 35124 and the name of its initial registered agent at this address is Susan G. Tucker.

6. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is one, and the name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of shareholders and until their successors are elected and shall qualify are as follows:

8. Each shareholder shall have a pre-emptive right to purchase shares of any class of capital stock of the corporation, including treasury shares.
