ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
CLAIMSHELP, INC.

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA:

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Code of Alabama, 1975, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is ClaimsHelp, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Alabama Corporate Law.

Without limitation of the foregoing, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

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To engage in the business of providing services to the insurance industry for the adjustment, investigation and appraisal of claims and to provide any services in connection therewith, including any business and commercial activities related to or in the furtherance of the purposes for which the corporation is organized, or for any other lawful purpose, and to exercise to the fullest extent possible all powers available to corporations organized under the Alabama Business Corporation Laws.

To do everything necessary, proper, advisable or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or associated with others, and incidental or pertaining to, or growing out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Alabama.

To serve in an advisory, managerial and consultative capacity to corporations, associations, partnerships, individuals, and others, and to establish and maintain bureaus, departments, and branches in the area of claims adjustment and investigation.

To purchase or otherwise acquire goods, merchandise, and personal property of every class, and to hold, own, mortgage, sell or otherwise dispose of, trade, deal in and deal with same.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CLAIMSHELP, INC.

To acquire, and pay for, in cash, stock or bonds of this corporation or otherwise, the good will, right, assets and property, and to undertake or assume the whole or any of the obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation.

To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, association or corporation.

Without limit as to amount, to borrow money, issue notes, bonds or negotiable paper or mortgage, pledge or otherwise transfer or convey the real and personal property to secure the payment of money borrowed or any debts contracted in the manner provided by status.

To subscribe for, acquire, hold and dispose of the stock, bonds or other evidence of indebtedness of any other corporation of this or any other state or foreign country, and while owner thereof, to exercise the rights, privileges and powers of ownership, including the right to vote such proxies, privileges and powers.

To carry on business in any of the States, Territories, Colonies or Dependencies of the United States, in the District of Columbia and in any and all foreign countries, to have one or more offices therein and therein to acquire, hold, transfer, mortgage and convey real and personal property, without limit as to amount, but always subject to local laws.

To do any or all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of Alabama upon corporations.

The objects and purposes specified in the foregoing clauses shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference therefrom, the terms of any other clause in these Articles of Incorporation, but the objects and purposes specified in each of the foregoing clauses of this article shall be regarded as independent objects and purposes.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is One-Hundred shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value of capital common stock.

FIFTH: The shares of stock issued by the corporation shall be of one class.

SIXTH: The shares of stock are issued within and under the provisions of Section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States.

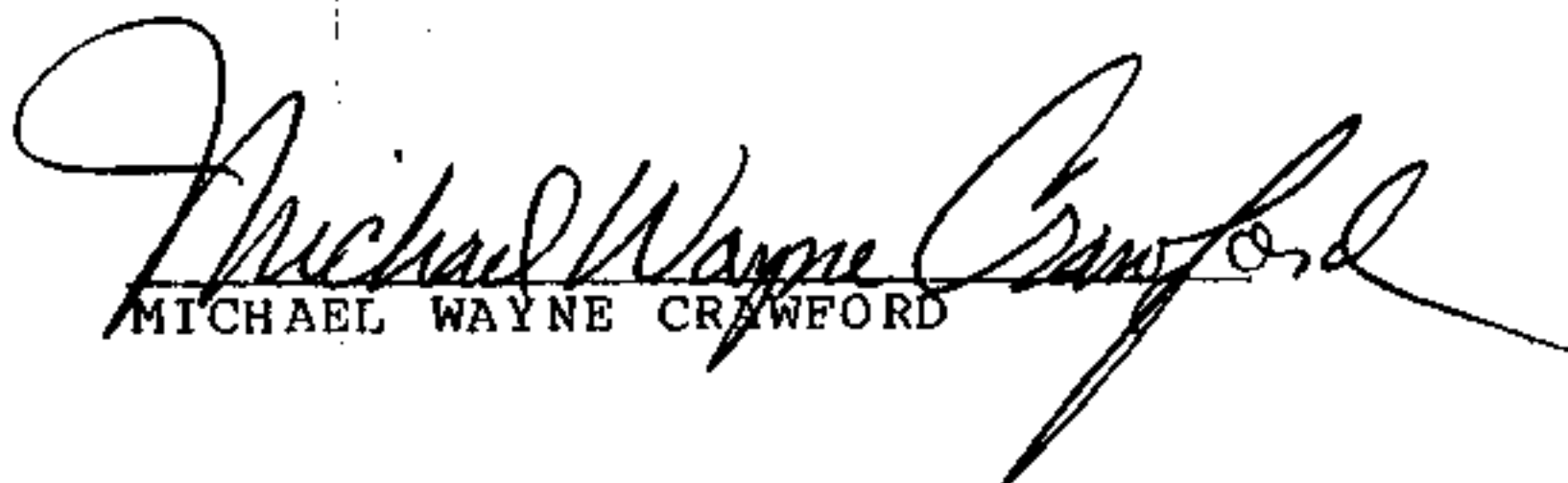
