

ORDER



This matter comes before the Court on the Motion by Lighting & Lamp Wholesalers, Inc., for an entry of default judgment. It appears that the motion is well taken and due to be granted.

Therefore, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

1. Judgment against James E. Bishop is entered in the amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars and Ninety-Four cents (\$2,227.94), plus attorney's fees in the amount of Three Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars and Two Cents (\$349.02), plus prejudgment interest in the amount of One Dollar and Ten Cents (\$1.10) per diem from February 28, 1991, up and until and including the date of judgment, and costs of Court.

2. That a lien in favor of Lighting & Lamp Wholesalers, Inc., is established on the buildings, real estate and improvements on that certain real property located in Shelby County, to-wit:

Lot 113, Hickory Ridge Subdivision, Shelby County,  
Alabama, as recorded in Amended Map Book 11, Page 79.

3. That if upon the expiration of 30 days from the date of this Order the defendant James E. Bishop has failed to pay the full judgment amount as decreed including Court costs and post-judgment interest, then the plaintiff may petition this Court for


