The notes signed by Dr. Charles Maben Johnson, had no time element or interest. He was to repay this debt when he was financially able. Several times he has written to me he would take care of this just debt. If he fails to pay me during his life time, at his death this indebtedness shall be included in his estate and the money collected be put in the special fund.

Article III- (A)

I hereby give and bequeath to Mrs. Harry Wade the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) to be hers absolutely. It is my wish, but it shall not be compulsory, that the said Mrs. Harry Wade, use the bequest for her personal use.

(B)

I hereby give, devise and bequeath to Jake Young and his son Robert Young, or survivors among them, the lot and house located at 3308-27th Avenue North, Birmingham, Alabama. I want Jake Young to collect the rent and keep the house so he will always have a home. This house must be kept in good repair. Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) cash shall be given to Jake Young to pay on his new car.

(C)

I hereby give and bequeath the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) to Chapel Hill Cemetery, Whitwell, Tennessee, to be invested in the Dunlap Bank. The interest shall only be used to keep all Hargis and Smith graves and Stones repaired and to place flowers on Memorial days.

To Mary Charlotte Johnson I bequeath one hundred (\$100.00) dollars to purchase something she wants to remember the Hargis family by.

(G) I hereby give and bequeath my medical library to Doctor James E. Lee.

(H)  
My wife, Florence Parker Hargis, will help my family in the future, if she feels help is needed. The money shall come from her estate.

(I)  
I wish to see Charles Estes, Fred and Mike Pfaff educated. To my wife, Florence Parker Hargis, I request that she supervise their education fund and I would like for them to have advanced education, and to select a Texas School so they may qualify for scholarship under their deceased Aunt's program, Dr. Minnie L. Maffett.

(J)  
Jessie and Turner Smith, servants at Daffodil Hills, Shelby County, Alabama, are to use the house in which they live, as long as they live. At their death, the land where the house stands shall become part of Hargis Chapel Grounds. I request my wife, Florence Parker Hargis, to keep the house in good repair, and to look after Jessie and Turner Smith during any illness and during their last days.

Rev. Tom Giltner and Mr. Paul Vaughan. These trustees are to advise  
my wife, Florence Parker Hargis. It is my express intention and desire  
that the trust and trust fund, shall be tax exempt, and the trustees  
shall use all of the income and corpus of the trust estate for the  
purposes of either establishing college education grants, or medical  
research, or the construction of a hospital, or the construction of  
a Nursing Home at the Hargis Christian Retreat. The trustees shall  
receive, hold and manage and administer the trust fund until such time  
as they determine to invest such fund in the construction or enlargement  
or improvement of medical or educational facilities.

I wish Mr. Maurice Bishop to draw up the powers and the authority of  
the trustees in the administration of the Trust Fund. He shall be  
permanent chairman of the Trust Fund.
