I I, Florence Parker Hargis, a resident
 of Laguna Beach Fla., Bay County
 wish to make my will. I am
 over twenty-one and I am mentally
 sound of mind and body.

II My just debts are to be paid
 and an inscription on the
 marble slab in Dr. Estes H. Hargis'
 Mausoleum shall be placed.
 Funds shall be set up to clean
 the mausoleum in each Nov. The
 Administrator of Hargis Christian
 Retreat will see that this cleaning
 is done. Bill Pfaff and any of his
 boys may be buried in the mausoleum.
 or the graves outside of the mausoleum.

III My property, stocks, bonds, and savings
 accounts shall be listed in a separate
 sheet. This money, maybe keep in
 tact and use the principal to
 produce more funds, and use the
 interest each year. At the request
 of my husband The Dr. Estes H. Hargis
 Charitable and Educational fundation
 will have my name: Florence Parker
 added to the fundation

Wish Maurice Bishop or one of his

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associates, Kirk Jackson broker
at Bache and Co., Mrs. Harvey Wade and
Paul Vaughan to decide what to
do with my holdings.

IV I wish to appoint Maurice Bishop,
Mrs. Harvey Wade to be my executor
with out bond.

V My real property goes to William Fredrick
Pfaff and his three boys - The great
house goes to Charles Estes Pfaff, my
house goes to Fred and Mike Pfaff.
William Fredrick Pfaff may live in
this house during his life time and
then the property goes to Fred and
Mike Pfaff. The lot located at Destin
goes to William Fredrick Pfaff Jr.

VI Hargis Christian Retreat
tract of land in Shelby Co. Hargis Alabama
with a good sized lake was given to the
First Christian Church of Birmingham Ala.
to establish a Hargis Christian Retreat.
If the name Hargis Christian Retreat
dropped from the name of the retreat
the land and building reverts to
the Hargis (Estes and Florence) Foundation.
The things included (1) Bought
part of the rightway (2) Built part
Florence Parker Hargis

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of swimming pool and bath house
(3) and deepened the lake's gorges
near Hargis Memorial Chapel. 4 Built
and furnished Hargis Memorial
Chapel. The chapel wasn't included
in the retreat's gift. This gift was
to become a community and
state chapel under the supervision
of the administration of Hargis Christian
Retreat and the Retreat's Committee
which is made up of members of the
First Christian Church.

Dr. Estes H. Hargis wanted the world
to feel the impact one feels when
they visit the retreat - the awareness
of our creator. He set up complete
financial aid for the chapel - insurance,
up keep and utilities - There were to
have all doors unlocked and no
money given, no political, church or
civil discussions. It was built as a
house of prayer. A consultation
room was added to accommodate any
discussions.

After Dr. Hargis' death a guest house
was built in memory of Mary Parker Pfaff
and a small dormitory in memory
of Laura V. Hargis. This dormitory
was given to the retreat.

VII The Hargis Memorial Chapel and The
Florence Parker Hargis

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Guest house will become a part of Hargis Community or Retirement Center. The guest house maybe used by my family and the retreat's guests. One bedroom and bath and the new added room will be used during Rosemary Hargis' life, if she desires it. Her loyalty and work developing the retreat are appreciated.

One hundred thousand dollars will be set up to be used by Hargis' Christian Retreat upkeep, insurance and utilities. The utilities will only include the chapel and guest house. This money will be put out on interest and only the interest can be used. This fund will be under the direction of the Administrator of Hargis' Christian Retreat and the sect, which will be appointed by First Christian Church, when the special account is established it must have the administrator and sect's name on checks issued. First National Bank will be head of this foundation.

IX

My land, the museum, Turner Smith's cottage, shop and barn, will be included in the new development of what shall be known "Hargis Community or Retirement - Rest Home Center". The land known as Daffodil Hill's Florence Parker Hargis.

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and the timber shall be left in-
fact. Its my wishes wild flowers,
trees and shrubs, paths shall be
maintained and cultivated, no trees
shall be cut unless diseased -
One hundred thousand dollars shall
be invested and the interest only
shall be used to insure and
take care of the property. A board
shall be set by the organization
who shall develop the rest home,
or nursing home. The chapel shall
be shared with Hargis Christian
Retreat.

The museum shall be left in-
fact. The shop will have the
crafts and antique tools and
other old style articles.

Should the rest home - nursing
home be established on the lake
front, Maurice Bishop and the
committee shall draw up legal
papers which will protect my land

IV At my death the Mr. Ester H. Hargis Charitable and Educational Foundation shall read Mr. Ester H. and Florence Parker Hargis Charitable and Educational Foundation. The residue of my estate will be applied to this foundation.

The money shall be put out on interest, and the property, stocks and bonds should be carefully evaluated. The 100 acres at Signal Mt. Tenn. should be kept intact until a good investment is considered. For turned down 1000 acre. The interest of the foundation should be given each year. The following places I wish to be considered.
